ITINERARY

Day 1, September 20, Tuesday, DEPARTURE

You'll leave from US with an overnight Flight to Istanbul, Turkey.

Day 2, September 21, Wednesday, ISTANBUL

Welcome to turkey. You are greeted by your tour guide and transferred to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

Day 3, September 22, Thursday, ISTANBUL

After breakfast, full day city tour of magnificent **Istanbul**, the city that links two continents **Asia** and **Europe** to each other. Visit **Topkapi** the palace of the Sultans, **Hagia Sophia**, the magnificent former Christian Basilica, the **Blue Mosque** and the **Grand Bazaar**, with over 4000 little shops. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

Day 4, September 23, Friday, ISTANBUL, CANAKKALE-TROY

After breakfast we will drive along the Sea of Marmara to Canakkale. We will cross the Dardanelles, where you will see **Gallipoli**, the famous site of World War I battle. Visit **Troy** and see the city made famous in Homer's poems, as the center of the Trojan War, including the legendary **Trojan Horse**. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.

Day 5, September 24, Saturday, CANAKKALE, TROY, PERGAMUM, EPHEBUS

After breakfast, drive by Troas, where Paul had a vision in which he was called to Macedonia (Greece). Visit **Pergamum** where the first Christians were executed by Rome. This was the most favored of the Seven Churches, and Christianity came here very early. You will see the **Temple of Zeus**, and the **Temple of Athena**, the fabled **Acropolis** and the **Royal Gate**. Here parchment was developed replacing papyrus. You will also see **Asclepion**, from distance one of the foremost healing centers of the ancient world. Dinner and overnight in Ephesus.

Day 6, September 25, Sunday, EPHEBUS, VIRGIN MARY'S HOUSE

After breakfast visit the most complete magnificent ancient city ever excavated. Tour the **antique city**, Ephesus, with its theatre, library, Temple of Artemis, declared as one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. We will have a Mass at **Virgin Mary's House in Ephesus**. Tradition tells us that the Apostle accompanied Mary to Ephesus. Dinner and overnight in Ephesus.

Day 7, September 26, Monday, EPHEBUS, ST. JOHN, DIDYMA, MILETUS

After breakfast, we will have Mass at the **Basilica of St. John** and visit his **tomb**. Then proceed to the antic city of **Didyma** to see the famous Temple of Apollo. After lunch we will continue to **Miletus** where St. Paul stopped on his Third Missionary Journey, assembled and addressed the elders of Ephesus, on his way back to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Ephesus.

Day 8, September 27, Tuesday, EPHEBUS, KUSADASI, PATMOS

After breakfast we will embrace cruise ship. Our first stop is the sacred island of **Patmos**, where John received the mystical Revelation, which forms the last book of the New Testament. The **optional excursion** takes you to the **Grotto of the Revelation**. And the 11-century Monastery of St. John (which houses the original script of the Gospel).

Day 9, September 28, Wednesday, RHODOS

Today the ship docks in **Rhodes**, the island Paul visited during his third journey as he sailed toward Jerusalem. Tour the medieval city where the Crusaders gathered before sailing to the Holy Land, and the Knights of St. John built the magnificent town. Or take an **optional** tour to the majestic **Acropolis of Lindos** and tile old town built by the Crusaders.

Day 10, September 29, Thursday, HERAKLION (CRETE), SANTORINI

This morning we ship will stop at Greek island of Heraklion. Heraklion is the home of fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Discovered in 1899 and partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture. Visit the island on your own or take an optional trip offered by the cruise line. Afternoon we will visit the Island of Santorini, This island is perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands. In the town of Thira white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes and glittering boutiques cling to steep cliffs, accessible by cable-car or mule. Vissit the island on your own or take an optional trip offered by the cruise lines.

Day 11, September 30, Friday, PIRAEUS, ATHENS

After arriving to the mainland of Greece we will embark on a city tour including the **Agora** where Paul preached. Here Socrates thought and was forced to drink the deadly hemlock. On **Mars Hill**, Paul was brought before the council and delivered his great sermon. You will visit the ancient town of **Acropolis** to see the **Parthenon**, the **theater of Dionyssos**, the **Temple of the Wingless Victory** and other sights, which reflect the golden age of Greece. Dinner and overnight Athens.

Day 12, October 1, Saturday, ATHENS, USA

After breakfast, we will take a flight to home.



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TOUR

INSURANCE: Insurance coverage is not included in the tour prices. Travelers are highly encouraged to purchase their travel insurance. Payment for travel insurance should be made directly to the insurance company within **FOURTEEN (14) days of initial deposit payment**. Please call **Travelex Insurance Company at 1-800-228-9792** and purchase your insurance by phone. Please do not forget to mention to them our **Location ID# which is 51-6011** and the cost of the trip without taxes.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS:

Ninety (90) days or more prior to the departure, a **NON-REFUNDABLE** service fee of \$100 per person will apply; 89 to 60 days prior to the departure, a cancellation of 25% of tour cost will apply; 59 to 30 days prior to the departure, a cancellation of 50% of tour cost will apply; 29 to 15 days prior to the departure, a cancellation of 75% of tour cost will apply; 14 days or less prior to the departure, a cancellation of 100% of tour cost will apply. There will be no refunds on unused tour services. All airline tickets issued in conjunction with this tour are subject to separate airline penalties, per individual carrier's rules and regulations. The traveler (s) acknowledges receiving, reading, and agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth below.

Cancellations and request for refunds must be in writing. Cancellation fees will not be waived due to an illness. We highly recommend travel insurance for this reason.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: Random seats are assigned for all group participants. If you would like to secure a specific seat, or sit with a travel companion please advise us of such request at the time of booking, we will make an effort to accommodate you, however we cannot guarantee. If you must have specific seat we recommend you to be at the airport at least three hours prior to departure and arrange the seat assignment with your airline's gate agent. Bulkhead and exit row seating can never be requested prior to the day of departure. Glory Tours can NEVER guarantee any specific seats. Seats are at the sole discretion of the airline and are pending availability.

AIRPORT TAXES, SECURITY FEES, AND FUEL CHARGES: Airport taxes are collected at the time of final payment and paid to the airlines on your behalf at the time of ticketing.
